Today we have assembled to mourn the sudden demise of Anil B. Divan, Senior Advocate, who left us for his heavenly abode on 20th March, 2017.

Anil B. Divan was born on 15th May 1930. He has been described as an eminent constitutional expert. He was president of Law Asia from 1991 to 1993 and was Associate President of the Bar Association of India. He has argued in the Supreme Court of India on a "pro bono" basis in many Public Interest Litigations. He was also a member of the committee on Water Resources Law of the International Law Association. He was appointed by the government to help resolve Cauvery Water Disputes. Divan was a member of the Committee on Judicial Accountability too.

Over the years, Divan had established himself as one of the nation's foremost jurists, having appeared in a number of landmark cases in the Supreme Court of India such as challenge to the NJAC Act, Oleum gas leak case, Bhopal Gas Tragedy case etc. Apart from these cases, he also appeared in the challenge to the Prevention of Terrorism Act and in the *Rupa Ashok Hurra* case, which laid down the law related to curative petitions. More recently, he was appointed as amicus curiae in BCCI case.

His sudden demise is undoubtedly a great loss to the legal fraternity as well as to his family.

I, on my behalf and on behalf of my esteemed colleagues and also members of the Registry, convey our heartfelt condolence to the members of the bereaved family and pray the Almighty to grant eternal peace to the departed soul and give strength to the members of his family to reconcile to and bear the irreparable loss.

And as a mark of respect to the departed soul, I request learned members of the Bench and Bar to observe one minute's silence.

The court work will remain suspended for the rest of the day as a mark of respect to the departed soul.
